Adding standard subdivisions from Table 1

Notation from Table 1 Standard Subdivisions may be added to any number in the schedules unless there is a specific instruction to the contrary. A standard subdivision represents a recurring physical form (such as a dictionary, periodical, or index) or approach (such as history or research) and thus is applicable to any subject or discipline. Here are a few examples:

- 150.5 Periodical on psychology
- 230.003 Dictionary of Christianity
- 340.02573 Directory of lawyers in the U.S.
- 401 Philosophy of language
- 507.8 Use of apparatus and equipment in the study and teaching of science, e.g., science fair projects

- 796.912092 Biography of a figure skater
- 808.0071 Teaching of rhetoric

The classifier should never use more than one zero in applying a standard subdivision unless instructed to do so. If more than one zero is needed, the number of zeros is always indicated in the schedules. When using standard subdivisions with numbers built by adding from Tables 2 - 7 or other parts of the schedules, be sure to check the table or schedule used for the segment preceding the standard subdivision for special instructions on the number of zeros

Standard subdivisions should be added only when the work in hand covers the whole, or approximately the whole, of the subject of the number. For example, there is no number for black widow spiders under 595.44, the number for spiders. Do not, therefore, assume that black widows are "just another spider," and start using 595.440972 for an account on black widow spiders in Mexico. Stop at 595.44, where works on black widow spiders have standing room pending further development of the schedule.

Do not add one standard subdivision to another standard subdivision unless specifically instructed.

Phoenix table: Biology (fra Manual)

The main point to remember in classifying works that treat both a specific biological subject and a specific kind of organism is that the subject takes precedence in 571-575 (the span devoted to internal processes and structures), while the organism takes precedence in the rest of biology.

Comprehensive works on subjects other than internal processes and structures are classed in 576-578, while works on these other subjects limited to specific kinds of organisms are classed with the kind of organism in 579-590.

152-158 vs. 150.19 Specific topics in psychology vs. [Psychological] Systems, schools, viewpoints

Certain schools and systems draw their fundamental principles from a few selected psychological topics. When such topics are used to illustrate a system, class with the system in 150.19, e.g., the subconscious, fantasies, and dreams used to illustrate psychoanalytic principles 150.195 (not 154). If in doubt, prefer the specific topic in 152-158.

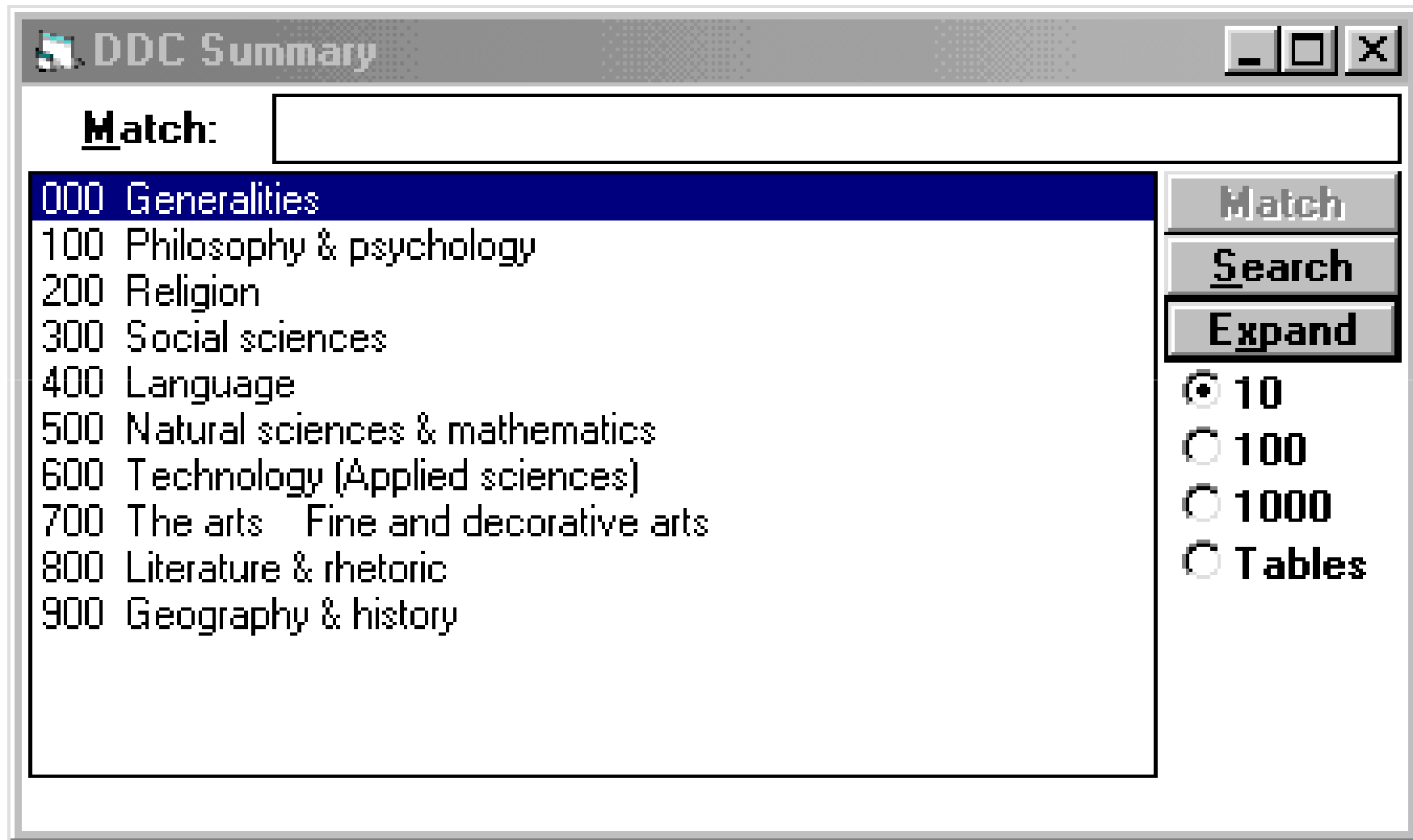




